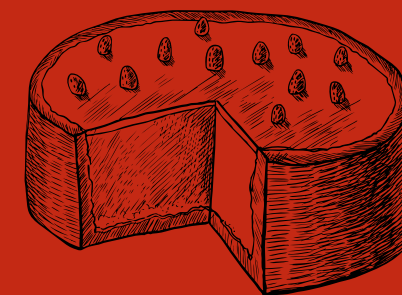

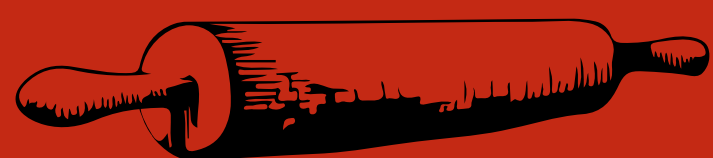


SYNOPSIS

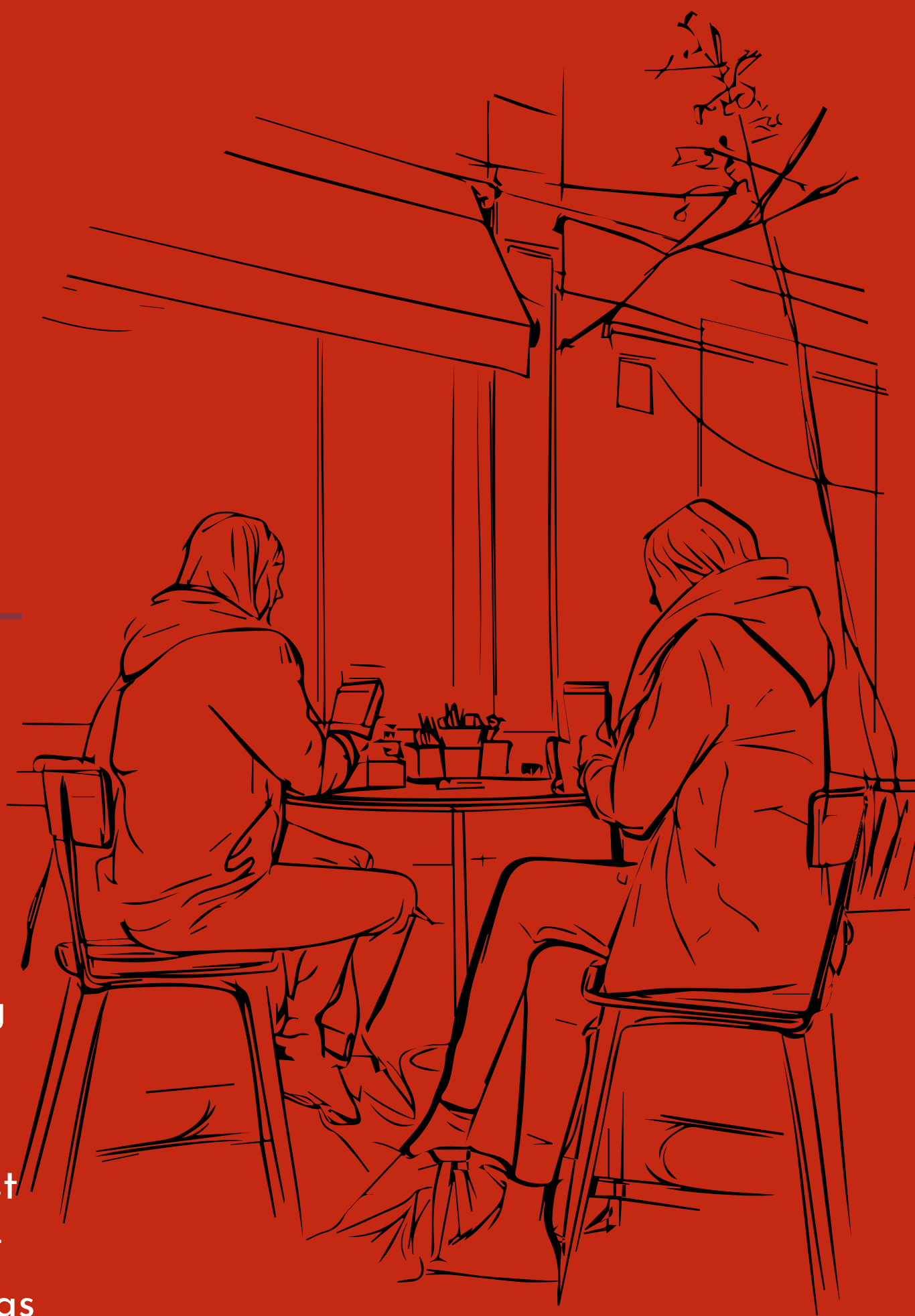
